

CITY ELDERS



English Standard Version 47 results in 22 verses

[Deut 19:12](#) then the [elders](#) of his [city](#) shall send and take him from there, and hand him over to the avenger of blood, so that he may die.

[Deut 21:3](#) And the [elders](#) of the [city](#) that is nearest to the slain man shall take a heifer that has never been worked and that has not pulled in a yoke.

[Deut 21:4](#) And the [elders](#) of that [city](#) shall bring the heifer down to a valley with running water, which is neither plowed nor sown, and shall break the heifer's neck there in the valley.

[Deut 21:6](#) And all the [elders](#) of that [city](#) nearest to the slain man shall wash their hands over the heifer whose neck was broken in the valley,

[Deut 21:19](#) then his father and his mother shall take hold of him and bring him out to the [elders](#) of his [city](#) at the gate of the place where he lives,

[Deut 22:17](#) and behold, he has accused her of misconduct, saying, “I did not find in your daughter evidence of virginity.” And yet this is the evidence of my daughter’s virginity.’ And they shall spread the cloak before the [elders](#) of the [city](#).

[Deut 22:18](#) Then the [elders](#) of that [city](#) shall take the man and whip him,

[Deut 25:8](#) Then the [elders](#) of his [city](#) shall call him and speak to him, and if he persists, saying, ‘I do not wish to take her,’

- [Exod 17:5](#) And the LORD said to Moses, “Pass on before the [people](#), taking with you some of the [elders](#) of Israel, and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go.
- [Exod 17:6](#) Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock at Horeb, and you shall strike the rock, and water shall come out of it, and the [people](#) will drink.” And Moses did so, in the sight of the [elders](#) of Israel.
